#### **SHF Membership**

Please note the SHF memberships are required to enter the show.

#### The Saskatchewan Horse Federation works towards achieving the following objectives:

- To provide leadership among recognized equine and equestrian organizations in Saskatchewan that each may be helped to achieve the highest level of success for its members.
- To co-ordinate the activities of the recognized equine and equestrian organizations in Saskatchewan so that duplication of effort and conflict of purpose may be avoided.
- To provide liaison with similar provincial equine councils, and with the Coaching Association of Canada, with the Canadian Federation of Provincial Horse Organizations, with the Horse Welfare Alliance of Canada, with Equine Canada, and with any other related national body as may exist for the conduct of sport, recreation and horse industry initiatives in Canada.
- To serve as an educational medium for its members by distributing information relative to the horse industry and equestrian activities by bringing speakers of authority to meetings of the Federation, and by organizing seminars and clinics.
- To develop and deliver programs and projects as appropriate to advance the needs and interests of the membership.
- To serve as a medium through which the provincial government and other agencies may make funds available to support equine and equestrian organizations and activities in Saskatchewan.
- To raise the standards of care and handling of all horses in Saskatchewan.
- SHF Heritage Circuit and SHF Prairie Cup nominations must be purchased prior to competition. If nominations are not received by the SHF before competition the points for the show won't count. Points earned during this show will count towards year-end awards. To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals, you must attend a minimum of two Heritage shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible. Heritage Circuit and Prairie Cup classes are indicated in the prize list.

### Saskatchewan Hunter Jumper Association

The goal of the Saskatchewan Hunter Jumper Association is to provide a strong support system for riders interested in the sport of show jumping and hunters. To enable and encourage all riders to compete at horse shows where hunter and jumper competitions are available. In order to achieve these goals the SHJA will provide education, horse shows, and clinicians available to all levels of hunter and jumper riders in Saskatchewan.

#### **General Rules and Regulations**

- **1.** The Summer Sun Series competition is sanctioned as a SHF Heritage and Prairie Cup event.
- **2.** Summer Sun Series Rules and Regulations Heritage and Prairie Cup rules will be enforced unless otherwise stated. All exhibitors must be Saskatchewan Horse Federation members.
- **3.** The show committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules to correct any errors or make any alternations that may be necessary in the prize list.

Any acts of discourtesy, dangerous or unsportsmanlike behavior or disobedience to the judges, officials, or show management by the owner, trainer, or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the horse show and the owner shall forfeit all fees.

- **4.** Inhumane treatment of a horse including polling, rapping, or other abuse shall not be tolerated. Violation of this rule shall result in immediate disqualification, and forfeiture of all fees and prizes.
- **5.** In the case of disqualification, the horse winning the succeeding prize shall receive the prize of the disqualified horse and the other prizes shall be adjusted accordingly.

- **6.** Competitors are allowed in the competition rings only when competing, during schooling rounds or when the course is open for walking.
- **7.** Courses will be posted one half hour before the start of each class.
- **8.** Neither Sandcastle Riding Club, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees, nor representatives of the Show Committee will be held responsible in any way for damage, injury or loss to persons, horses, tack, property, spectators or exhibitors. All exhibitors and/or guardians <u>MUST</u> sign the Acceptance of Risk form and return with entry form and fees.
- **9.** The shows starts at 8:00 a.m. sharp.
- **10.** Stallions may NOT be ridden by juniors.
- **11.** No Food service will be available on the grounds due to Covid restrictions.

- **13.** Horses that have been called to the ring will be required to enter the ring within 3 minutes or the ring will be closed to them.
- 14. Heritage Classes are marked as HC and

Prairie Cup Series are marked as PC

- **15.** Once a class has begun (the gate shut, or the first horse judged) no further entries will be accepted.
- **16.** Hunter Division: A horse may compete in any three (3), but only three (3) consecutive class heights, and a maximum of four (4) over-fence classes per day, including specials, classics, derbies, medals, or equitation over fences.
- **17.** A horse or pony that has competed "Hors Concours" is not permitted to be judged in the same ring on the same day.
- **18.** Parking for trailers and spectators will be designated to the first area directly off Clarence Avenue and Hill Street.
- **19.** In case of emergency please exit the property immediately through the entrance that you entered.

#### **Memberships**

**1.** SHF membership is required for all competitors.

#### **Birth Date**

 Juniors under the age of 18 as of January 1, 2021 may, with consent of parent or guardian, ride in any class, except where otherwise stipulated.

#### Numbers and Fees

- There is an office fee of \$30, an EMT fee of \$10 per rider, and a refundable number deposit of \$10 per horse.
- 2. Each horse will be allotted a number. No rider will be permitted to show, or school, or ride on the property without a number, and points shall be credited to the number worn. Any error made due to rider wearing a wrong number will cancel points credited in that class.
- **3.** Back numbers are encouraged to be worn in all under saddle classes. The refundable number deposit applies to back numbers.

#### **Entries**

- **1.** Entries for the 2021 Summer Sun Horse Show Series must use the appropriate Summer Sun entry form.
- 2. Entries must be in the hands of the show committee by the closing date printed on the entry form to receive the early bird discount.
- **3.** Entries received by August 16<sup>th</sup> will receive an early entry discount of \$10. New entries received after the closing date of August 27<sup>th</sup> or made on the day of the show will pay an additional fee of \$25.00.
- **4.** Entry forms must be accompanied by a cheque, E-mail transfer, or money order to cover all entry fees, office fees, or any other applicable fees.
- **5.** NSF cheques will result in an additional \$35.00 service fee.
- **6.** Competitors are responsible for their own errors or those of their agents in preparation of their entry forms. Juniors must have a parent or guardian sign their entry form.
- **7.** All competitors will be required to leave an open cheque at the show office upon check in, to cover any additional expenses incurred during the horse show.
- **8.** Entries for classes must be complete by 10:00 am the day of the show. This will allow the show committee to make decisions regarding cancellation of classes.
- **9.** Horses may cross enter any or all divisions except where stated in the prize list.
- **10.** The show management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill to their satisfaction.
- **11.** Classes may be split if entries warrant. All entries must be made in writing and signed by the owner or agent. Entry fees **MUST** accompany entry form. One number will be assigned to each horse. Correct numbers must be worn and clearly visible at all times when riding on the grounds. No number will be issued unless all fees have been paid.
- **12.** Classes that do not meet the minimum of 3 entries may still run under the following conditions: class fee applies, will be judged, ribbons will be awarded, prize money may be halved.

#### <u>Prizes</u>

- **1.** Ribbons will be given to sixth place in all classes.
- Points for Division Championships shall be awarded on the following basis: Placing (Points) 1<sup>st</sup> (6) 2<sup>nd</sup> (5) 3<sup>rd</sup> (4) 4<sup>th</sup> (3) 5<sup>th</sup> (2) 6<sup>th</sup> (1). Points will be accrued over SS1 and SS2 for Summer Sun Division Championships and Reserves.
- **3.** Payouts: [total payout: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>] \$35 class: \$12.25, 8.75, 7, 3.50, 1.75, 1.75 \$50 class: \$17.50, 12.50, 10, 5, 2.50, 2.50 \$75 class: \$26.25, 18.75, 15, 7.50, 3.25, 3.25 \$135 class: \$47.25, 33.75, 27, 13.50, 6.75, 6.75 \$200 class: \$70, 50, 40, 20, 10, 10 \$250 class: \$87.50, 62.50, 50, 25, 12.50, 12.50 \$300 class: \$105, 75, 60, 30, 15, 15 All prize money will be applied against the horse account. Any credits after the Show will be issued a pay-out. The payment will only be issued to the rider/owner as indicated on the entry form and will be paid out when the account is closed. Unless otherwise indicated on the entry form, all prize monies are awarded to the owner.

#### **Scratches**

 Cancellation of entries after closing date shall forfeit their entries, except where a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian is presented to the show office before the start of classes. Office administration fee of \$30 will be retained on all cancellations. Substitutions will be permitted for a fee of \$15 per entry.

#### **Stabling**

**1.** Stabling: No stabling is available on site.

#### SHJA PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

- **1.** SHJA membership is required for all Championship and medal classes.
- **2.** No cross entry between Provincial Championship classes.
- **3. Provincial Hunter champions** will be awarded by totaling the scores over two rounds. The hunter class for the corresponding height at SS1 will be the first round and the provincial championship class will be the second round. Ties will be decided by the highest placing in provincial championship class.
- **4. Provincial Jumper champions** will be awarded by totaling the placing points over two rounds.

#### Warm-Ups

- Schooling rounds in the hunter and jumper rings will be held from 12:00pm to 7:00pm August 27<sup>th</sup>.
- **2.** Warm up jumps will be available in the warm up ring.
- Schooling rounds will be available at a charge of \$15 per horse for ½ hour blocks. Please contact the show office at <u>vickendall@hotmail.com</u> to book.
- **4.** The entry number <u>MUST</u> be worn during schooling or exercising of horses or ponies.

#### <u>Dogs</u>

 Dogs should be left at home; however, if brought to the show, they must be on a leash at all times. Loose dogs will be impounded and owners fined \$25 for each offence.

#### Helmets and Attire

- ALL competitors riding in Hunter, Jumper and Hunter Seat Equitation divisions and classes over fences must wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness fitted in the helmet. Nylon web harness type is NOT allowed. This headgear MUST be worn at all times while schooling over fences in the designated schooling areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds.
- Hunter Ring braiding is optional and hunt jackets at all times. Exceptions maybe made. Jumper Ring – Collared shirts are allowed. Medal classes must adhere to proper attire.

The jumper class for the corresponding height will be the first round and the provincial championship class will be the second round. Ties will be decided by the highest placing in provincial championship class.

**5.** A horse/rider combination is only eligible to compete for one provincial championship.

#### **SHJA MEDAL FINALS**

- **1.** To be eligible to compete in the SHJA Medal Finals each rider must be a member of the SHJA.
- 2. Riders who have won a SHJA medal class during the 2021 year will receive free entry in the SHJA medal final class.
