Outcomes and Criteria Summary

All Equine Canada NCCP certified Competition Coach Specialist – Western coaches will be able to:

- 1. Plan lessons/schooling sessions and create an Emergency Action Plan
- 2. Support the Athlete in Training (Coach/Teach lessons/conduct schooling/training sessions)
- 3. Analyze performance of horses and riders
- 4. Make Ethical Decisions (Online evaluation)

NOTE - Outcomes #1 and #2 – Riders are in Competition context ie: They are preparing to go to a show. Competition Coach Specialists must achieve the **advanced** standard in outcomes #1, #2 and #3.

All Equine Canada NCCP certified Competition Coach Specialist – Western coaches will also be able to:

- 5. Design an Equestrian Sports Program
- 6. Manage an Equestrian Sports Program
- 7. Support the Competitive Experience

NOTE - Competition Coach Specialists must achieve the standard in outcomes #4, #5 and #6.

Outcome #1 – Plan Lessons/Schooling sessions and create an EAP (One only for home venue)

<u>Task</u>

Plan two lessons/schooling sessions:

- 1. Discipline Specific lesson
- 2. Discipline Specific lesson

The plan must include:

- 1. Logistics
- 2. Appropriate exercises
- 3. Emergency Action Plan (EAP)

NOTE - Templates are available for Lesson Plans and EAP

Outcome #2 - Provide Support to Riders/Horses in Training

<u>Task</u>

Coach Student(s) in Discipline Specific Lessons to improve the rider and horse.

Reining:

Lesson 1 - Coach one student on a topic of candidate's choice from discipline list.

Lesson 2 - Coach one student to ride an NRHA Reining pattern.

Lesson 3 - Coach one student on a topic of *evaluators' choice* from above NRHA pattern.

Speed Events: Barrel Racing & Pole Bending

Lesson 1 - Coach one student on a topic of candidate's choice from discipline list for either Barrel





Racing or Pole Bending.

Lesson 2 - Coach one student to ride a pattern appropriate for Lesson 1.

Lesson 3 - Coach one student on a topic of evaluators' choice from discipline list for the discipline not chosen by candidate.

General Performance: Three students - Western Pleasure, one student - Showmanship, Horsemanship, Trail, Western Riding (optional).

Lesson 1 - Coach student(s) to ride rail work or a pattern of candidate's choice for one of the above disciplines.

Lesson 2 - Coach student(s) to ride rail work or a pattern of *candidate's choice* for a different discipline than Lesson 1.

Lesson 3 - Coach student(s) on a topic of evaluators' choice from the discipline list, for a discipline not chosen by candidate in Lessons 1 or 2.

Lesson 4 - Coach student(s) on a topic of evaluators' choice from the discipline list, for a discipline not chosen by candidate in Lessons 1, 2 or 3 (candidate will coach a different discipline in each lesson).

The Candidate must:

- 1. Ensure that the lesson/schooling environment is safe
- 2. Implement an appropriately structured and organized lesson
- 3. Make interventions that promote learning

Outcome #3 - Analyze performance (Evaluated during the lessons)

The coach must:

- 1. Detect errors in riders and horses
- 2. Correct errors in riders and horses

Outcome #5 - Design a Sports Program

Task

Submit a Yearly Training Plan (YTP)

The coach must:

- Outline program structure based on available training and competition opportunities
 - a. Identify program measures to promote rider/horse development
 - b. Develop practice plans that integrate seasonal training priorities

Submit a Portfolio The coach must: Manage administrative aspects of program and oversees logistics

COMPETITIVE EXPERIENCE	 The Candidate must have achieved a minimum score of 68, under at least 2 different NRHA, CRC or Breed judges, on 3 or more runs. <i>OR</i> The Candidate's student(s) must have achieved a minimum score of 65, under at least 2 different NRHA, CRC or Breed judges, on 3 or more runs. If the Candidate student's(s') competitive experience is used, the student(s) must submit a signed letter indicating the Candidate was their coach at the time they achieved the scores.
