PARC/PA EX Light Horse Show Rules

Western Light Horse stalls will be available at 6:00PM Thursday, August 3rd 2022

Entries MUST Be Received by July 25th 2022!!

- 1) The show will be held under the rules of the SHF HERITAGE HANDBOOK
- 2) SHF Membership is **REQUIRED TO SHOW**
- 3) Buckle Series: Competitors highest points from TWO SHOWS out of the THREE OFFERED will be used to crown the All-Around ****MUST BE A PARC MEMBER** and must use the same horse through-out the entire season, unless a vet note stating the horse originally ridden cannot be used is presented and accepted. Must compete at a minimum of TWO shows out of THREE to qualify for the buckle**
- 4) If a tie for All-Around occurs, tie-breaker will most firsts, followed by most seconds, followed by a Coin-Toss.
- 5) Qualifying Classes: Points will be tabulated using the SHF point scale. Five or more in a class 5,4,3,2,1. Two in a class 2,1 Etc. Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail. Note: Stake classes, Halter and any open classes do not count towards All-Around.
- 6) Classes marked with SHF are Heritage Circuit approved classes, everyone may compete in any SHF class but, only Nominated horse/rider combinations with SHF will be eligible to earn points towards your yearend awards. To qualify for the SHF Provincial Finals you must attend a minimum of two Heritage shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to compete. You must also be a current SHF member to nominate.
- 7) Show is open to all breeds of horses registered or un-registered
- 8) Stallions are only to be handled and shown by adults over the age of 18 and must be mannerly or they will be excused by the executive
- 9) No horses shall never be tied to the fence or left unattended
- 10) All horses must be hand walked to and from the arena(s). No riding of horses is permitted outside the arena(s).
- 11) All horses must enter and exit out the south door of the barn and be walked behind the barns to get to the arena(s). No horses allowed on the pavement on the south side of the ring (between barns and arena)
- 12) Physical abuse of horses, over schooling or use of performance enhancing drugs will NOT BE TOLERATED
- 13) Prize money: 1st - \$15 2nd - \$10 3rd - \$5. If less than 5 exhibitors in the class the prize money will be adjusted accordingly. No prize money in equitation classes.
- 14) Stake class payout – each class will be placed to 5th with the top 4 horses splitting 80% of the pot divided in half and paid according to each judge placing
- 15) Executive reserve the right to correct any error or make any alterations to the regulations on the prize list
- 16) All numbers must be worn on back of competitor or on both sides of the saddle
- 17) English or Western attire and tack accepted in Showmanship
- 18) Chaps are optional in Western Classes
- 19) All competitors in English must wear an approved helmet with harness during competition and or practice
- 20) All juniors must wear ATSM approved protective headgear in or out of the ring
- 21) When the total number of entries in a Junior class is fewer than three, the executive reserves the right to amalgamate the class with any other class of the same type, and if the total of all juniors is less than six, the class will be combined as an all ages junior class.
- 22) Exhibitors are required to produce the animals in the ring for the purpose of being judged when called upon by the announcer in charge, otherwise their right to any prizes to which they might be entitled to will be forfeited.
- 23) No persons will be permitted in the show ring during the time of judging except for the judge and their assistants, exhibitors and the director in charge of the class being judged.

- 24) Any exhibitor who makes a false entry or who shall attempt to interfere with or influence the judges while in discharge of their duties, or who shall use contemptuous or abusive language to a judge, shall forfeit his/her right to all prizes/points he/she might otherwise be entitled to, and shall be excluded from exhibiting at future PARC shows.
- 25) Any exhibitor lodging a protest must make it in writing with proof to substantiate protest included, and it must be delivered to the Show Secretary within thirty minutes of the last class of the day, It must also be accompanied with a deposit of \$50.00 cash, which will be forfeited to PARC if the protest is not sustained, The protest will be reviewed at the first meeting following the show.
- 26) Liability: All exhibitors shall be under the control and direction of the PARC but solely at the risk of said exhibitor. The PARC will not be responsible for damage, injury, loss or theft of or to any exhibit, irrespective of the cause of such damage, injury, loss or theft. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury, or damage done to, administered by or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him/her, for its description as given in the catalogue. This shall indemnify the PARC against all legal or other proceeding in regard thereto.
- 27) One horse can only have one rider excluding Peewee, lead line and Jack Benny The names of the horse and exhibitor must be given for each class. No substitutions.
- 28) Any exhibitor who delays the judging by reason of his failure to produce his animals in the ring when their class is called may, at the discretion of the Holding Ring Attendant, be refused admission to the show ring and may forfeit his right to show such animals for a prize.
- 29) Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Officials, Volunteers, or Staff on the part of the owner, groom or exhibitor may disqualify a horse from adjudication as decided by the Show Committee.
- 30) All stock exhibitors will be required to have gate admission passes which must be ordered when making your entries. PASSES MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE GATE OR YOU WILL BE CHARGED REGULAR GATE ADMISSIONS. One vehicle pass will be supplied at no charge for each exhibitor.
- 31) Exhibitors cancelling their entries for whatever reasons after the officials closing date shall forfeit their fees. On Certification of disability from a qualified veterinarian being received in the Prince Albert exhibition office before 6:00pm on the final day of classes, entry fees only shall be returned.
- 32) A veterinarian must clear any horse on the grounds found to be sick or coughing in order for it to stay on the premises. Any costs incurred will be the responsibility of the owner. (Competitors please use discretion when bringing in horses).
- 33) All Junior Horse Classes may be asked to supply proof of age, copy of registration or certificate or veterinarian documents.
- 34) In case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding price awarded to the disqualified animal the other prizes shall be adjusted accordingly.
- 35) No exhibitor shall be permitted to show without a number. Any error made due to an exhibitor wearing a wrong number will cancel points credited to that exhibitor in that class. Numbers must be clearly visible.
- 36) STABLE FEES: Box stalls \$20.00/day, Tie stalls \$15.00/day. Early or late stalling arrivals must be approved by the committee. Box stall doors must be kept closed. Stallions must be stalled secure in the box stalls or tied with halter & stud collar. Stabling will be allocated by the Light Horse Committee without right of appeal and will be awarded by the first come basis. It may not be possible to accommodate all requests. Stabling fees must accompany entry form. Exhibitors will not move their assigned stalls.
- 37) TACK STALLS WILL BE DESIGNATED IF ENTRIES PERMIT. NO GROOMING OF HORSES IN AISLES. HORSES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN ANY AREA OF THE TRAILER PARK. BARNS MUST BE KEPT CLEAN AT ALL TIMES DURING THE FAIR. STALLS MUST BE LEFT IN CLEAN CONDITION WHEN CLASSES ARE FINISHED.
- 38) All registered members of participating Light Horse show will be required to purchase gate passes at time of entry. Each exhibitor may purchase up to 3 passes at \$25.00 per adult or \$15.00 per child (12 yrs. and under). These passes are good only for the days exhibiting. One vehicle pass per exhibiting family will be available upon request for 4-H show days only. All other passes must be purchased at regular gate prices. MAKE SURE TO ORDER PASSES WITH ENTRY.

- 39) All horses entered in the Light Horse Show must be in designated stalls or pay the Grounds Fee of \$10.00 for that only.
