ENTRY DEADLINE: Friday, April 30, 2021 (Note: Rides are limited to 60 per day, so get your entries in early!!).

REQUIREMENTS: Riders must have current SHF membership or other provincial equine association membership for liability insurance purposes; to enter the show. Senior riders at this show are permitted to wear cowboy hats as per the exemption from SHF. All Junior Riders are still required to wear a Riding Helmet

LOCATION: Doubles Down Arena, Moose Jaw, Sk.

ENTRY FEE POLICY: Riders that have a SWDA Membership will pay \$10.00 less for entry fees at SWDA Shows. Changes/cancellations of entries are allowed up to the deadline date of entry (Friday, April 30, 2021). Please note that after the deadline date of entry you will be responsible to remit payment for entries regardless of changes/cancellations made after the deadline date of entry. NO REFUND of entries will be given without a Medical/Veterinary Certificate (all refunds will be less office fees). For any changes/cancellations please reply back to the confirmation email (you will receive an email after entries are received) or send changes to **saskwesterndressage@gmail.com**. Another confirmation email will be sent with the changes.

OFFICE FEE: Office fee will only be charged for one day if you enter both days on the weekend.

AWARDS: All classes are offered as Open and Gaited with Junior divisions if entries warrant. Ribbons awarded to 4th place. Introductory, Basic, Level 1, Level 2 Tests will be offered at this show. If time allows a Rideability test will be offered at the end of each day. Entry for this will happen at the show.

RULES: This show is sanctioned by Western Style Dressage Association of Canada and by Saskatchewan Horse Federation. Show will use the WSDAC tests and rules and will also follow the SHF Rule Book.

Horse/Rider combinations are allowed to enter 2 different levels as long as they are consecutive Levels (Eg. Intro and Basic) **Are able to ride 4 tests per day**. (ie. 2 in the Introductory Level and 2 in the Basic Level or 4 in one level.) Rideability classes are not included in the 4 classes limit. **Gaited Horses Welcome**.

Heritage approved classes will count towards year end awards. Please ensure your SHF membership is current and that you have nominated if you are interested in accumulating points for the awards. To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals, you must attend a minimum of two Heritage shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible.

For all juniors it is mandatory that they wear ASTM or BSI approved helmets on the grounds during classes and practice ride times.

(Cruel, abusive, or inhumane treatment of a horse at any SWDA competition by an exhibitor, owner, trainer, or other person will not be tolerated anywhere on the grounds under any circumstances. SWDA supports any decision of officials or show committees that remove a horse from a competition due to obvious lameness or exhaustion. Cruelty can be defined as intentionally causing pain or unnecessary discomfort to a horse. The standard by which such conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be cruel, excessive, or inhumane.)

SHOWOFFICE: Open Saturday morning at 7 am. TEST LIST: Classes start at 9 am - Ride times to be announced Wednesday, May 12, Introductory and Basic Level Test A & B will be performed in the Small ring (40 meters x 20 meters). Basic Level Test C & D, Level 1 and Level 2 in the Standard Arena for this show (60 meters x 20 meters).
