## Trophy Show Series Championships

The Trophy Show Series, will be made up of 2 one day shows. Points will accumulate from the two events that make up the series. The Series Championships will be awarded at Show 2 for the following divisions.

- Micro Hunter – X-rail and 2'
- Low Hunter – 2'3" and 2'6"
- High Hunter – 2'9" and over
- Low Jumper - 1.0m and under
- High Jumper – 1.10m and over

Schooling classes, Specials, Medals and Clear Round jumper classes will not count towards these awards.



### SASKATCHEWAN HORSE FEDERATION

SHF Heritage Circuit and SHF Prairie Cup nominations must be purchased prior to competition. If nominations are not received by the SHF before competition the points for the show won't count. Points earned during this show will count towards year-end awards. To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals, you must attend a minimum of two Heritage shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible. Heritage Circuit and Prairie Cup classes are indicated in the prize list.



### SASKATCHEWAN HUNTER JUMPER ASSOCIATION

Saskatchewan Hunter Jumper Association memberships are required for participation in SHJA medal classes. If memberships are not received by the SHJA before the class starts the points won't count.

# Attention Competitors

Class schedule is subject to change! All breaks will be announced at the show. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the daily schedule of classes posted on notice boards at the show office. Championship presentations will take place after placing last class of division.

## GENERAL RULES

1. The Trophy Show is sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.
2. All classes are conducted according to the guidelines provided in the current Saskatchewan Horse Federation Heritage and Prairie Cup rule book.
3. The management committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any errors or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list.
4. The management committee reserves the right to remove any groom, owner, trainer, manager, or rider from the horse show without compensation should that individual exhibit dangerous or unsportsmanlike behavior or harm to a horse.
5. Any acts of discourtesy, or disobediences to the judges or officials by the owner, rider, manager, trainer, or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the horse show and the owner shall forfeit all fees.
6. In the case of disqualification, the horse winning the succeeding prize shall receive the prize of the disqualified horse and the other prizes shall be adjusted accordingly.
7. Competitors will not be assigned a bridle number until the signed waiver portion of the entry form is received in the Show Office. By signing the waiver, riders, owners and agents are agreeing to abide by the SHF and prize list rules.
8. At the discretion of the Show Committee, a class may be cancelled or combined if fewer than five (5) entries are received. If less than five entries, prize money will be 50% of that indicated.
9. **2021 NEGATIVE COGGINS test required for entry.** Trophy Show is an SHF "A" designated EIA show.
10. Trophy Show will run in accordance to the SHA Covid safety requirements for horse events. **Face masks and social distancing are required at all times. No spectators are allowed.** One groom/parent per horse may attend as support, name must be provided prior to arrival.

## MEMBERSHIPS

1. All riders must have a valid 2021 Saskatchewan Horse Federation or other provincial sport organization membership.
2. Saskatchewan Hunter Jumper Association (SHJA) membership is required for all SHJA medal classes. SHJA Memberships are available at the Show Office.
3. Juniors are riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current year. Age of juniors must be stated on the entry form and birth certificates are to be available on request.  
Junior A - 15 to 17 years   Junior B - 12 to 14 years   Junior C - 11 years & under   Senior - 18 years & over

## NUMBERS

1. All competitors will be assigned a number for each horse. It is important in practice areas and competition rings that the horse number is clearly displayed. The use of a wrong number or having no number may result in disqualification from the competition. If you need Bridle numbers, they must be ordered in advance on the entry form.

## HARD HATS AND ATTIRE

1. It is mandatory that all persons mounted on a horse anywhere on the competition grounds wear approved headgear certified by SEI or another testing body that meets the American Society for Testing Materials (ASTM) standard or the British Standards Institution (BSI) standard.
2. Hunter Ring – braiding and hunt jackets recommended. Jumper Ring – hunt jackets recommended for specials.

## CLASS RULES

1. Horses may cross-enter any or all divisions EXCEPT where stated in the Prize List.
2. Ponies may be ridden by adults. No height or distance adjustments will be made for ponies.
3. Low Hunter (2'6") - open only to horse/rider combinations that are competing 2'6 and lower. This class is a part of the Low Hunter division.
4. Schooling Hunters will be placed with ribbons awarded but no points will be assigned for championships.
5. Horses may compete in a maximum of four over fences classes and 3 consecutive heights per day.

## **ENTRIES**

1. Separate entry forms must be filled out for each horse/rider combination
2. Entries must be in the hands of the show secretary by the closing date to avoid late fee.
3. Entry forms must be accompanied by a cheque, cash or e-transfer to cover all entry fees, offices fees and any other applicable fees.
4. NSF cheques will result in an additional \$25 service fee. We do not accept credit cards. Email transfers encouraged.
5. Competitors are responsible for their own errors or those of their agents in preparation of their entry forms. Juniors must have a parent or guardian sign their entry form.
6. Entries received after the closing date will be subject to a \$25 late fee.
7. All competitors will be required to leave an open cheque at the show office upon check in, to cover any additional expenses incurred during the horse show. This shall be in addition to the cheque or e-transfer sent to cover initial fees.
8. The management reserves the right to limit entries in any division and to refuse or decline any entry without being liable for compensation or damages.
9. Proof of a negative coggins test, dated within the calendar year, must be submitted with each entry form.
10. Horse/rider combinations can choose to enter one or both days. Only one office fee will be charged.

## **HORS CONCOURS**

1. Horses shall be allowed to compete "hors concours" with permission from the organizing committee but are subject to the same scoring rules as a regular entry with respect to falls, elimination etc. Such entries are not judged and are not eligible for the jump off.
2. A horse or pony that has competed "hors concours" is not allowed to compete subsequently in the same ring on the same day.
3. "Hors concours" entries will follow the last regular entry in the class.
4. "Hors concours" entries are not allowed in Hunter Divisions, Equitation and Medal classes.
5. "Hors concours" will count toward the maximum of 4 over fences classes per the day.

## **PRIZES**

1. Ribbons will be awarded to fifth place in all classes except Medal Classes, No ribbons for clear rounds.  
The prize money in shall be split: 1<sup>st</sup>=40%, 2<sup>nd</sup>=30%, 3<sup>rd</sup>=20%, 4<sup>th</sup>=10%
2. Prize money will be credited to closing accounts or paid out within 30-days as applicable.
3. Points for championships shall be awarded on the following basis:  
PLACING POINTS: 1<sup>st</sup> - 6 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> - 4 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> - 3 points; 4<sup>th</sup> - 2 points; and 5<sup>th</sup> - 1 point

## **SCRATCHES**

1. Exhibitors cancelling their entries after the official closing date, but prior to the start of the show shall, upon presentation of a valid veterinarian certificate, forfeit their offices fees, but will be refunded all other fees.
2. Non-veterinarian scratches will not be refunded.
3. Substitutions will be permitted, prior to the start of the show, for a fee of \$50.00.

## **FACILITY**

1. No stabling available on site.
2. No onsite concession.
3. There will be designated parking areas on the grounds for trailers and competitors' vehicles.

## **WARM UP**

1. Hunter and Jumper warm-up rounds are available for \$15.00/horse. Group times may be booked. Please call or text Vic at 306.241.2579 to reserve a time slot. Sign up on individual entry forms.

## **DOGS**

1. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. For safety and sanitary reasons, no dogs will be permitted in the schooling area, Show Office, concession areas, or show rings.
