Entries will be processed on a first come, first served basis as the show is limited to 8 hours of judging per day. Entries will not be considered received until all required documentation and full payment is received.

General Rules:

Participants are requested to read all rules governing this show. For English classes, the Saskatchewan Horse Federation rules will apply and for Western classes, the WSDAC rules will apply.

This event requires **proof of negative Coggin's** within 180 days of event. Negative Coggin's documentation **must** be provided with your show entry form. Entries will not be processed until this document is received. EHV 1&4 vaccines are recommended in addition to the core vaccinations recommended by your veterinarian.

All riders **MUST** wear an approved ASTM or SEI approved helmet at all times while mounted on show grounds as required by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.

Show Rules:

All riders must be current members of the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.

Numbers must be worn by all horses when not stabled. This includes hand-walking while on property, lunging, warm-ups, and while in the competition ring. Riders must provide their own numbers.

Schooling is permitted in designated areas only. Lunging is permitted in designated areas only.

Horses and riders are restricted to competition at 2 consecutive levels.

Each horse is restricted to a maximum of 4 tests per day, regardless of rider.

All classes are being run as open with no age designations.

Ride times will be assigned and published on the Saskatoon Dressage Club Facebook page.

It is the responsibility of riders to present themselves at the in-gate promptly at their assigned ride times. Riders who do not arrive on time will be eliminated from the class and forfeit their entry fees.

Abuse or inhumane treatment of horses, as well as unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Show management reserves the right to excuse those who are witnessed to commit such offenses.

The judge may not be directly approached. Any issues shall be taken to the show committee.

Readers will not be provided. Riders must arrange their own reader.

Hors concurs tests are permitted. The test fee remains the same.

The gate will not be closed for any test with the only possible exception being the para tests if deemed necessary.

All horses entered must be in good health and be up to date on core recommended vaccinations.

Due to the current Covid situation it is preferred if each rider brings a **maximum of 1 support person**. Spectators are strongly discouraged. The use of masks is mandatory for all. The practise of social distancing is strongly encourage, especially when masking isn't feasible.

Please also bring you own water and food, there will be **no concession**!

Liability

It is to be understood that neither East Edge Equestrian, Saskatoon Dressage Club, SHF, WSDAC, the show committee, judges, volunteers, or show manager shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss that may happen, from any cause or circumstances whatsoever, to competitors or anyone on the ground during the competition or to any animal or property brought on show grounds or for any loss, claim, matter, circumstance or event in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the show or any journey to and from the show.

Release of Liability form must be signed by all riders or guardians and included with show entry form in order for entries to be processed.

Covid waivers will be handed out when arriving to site, to ensure that the current public health guidelines can be reflected. Waivers must be signed by all persons entering the show grounds.

Facility:

Stabling is mandatory. Weekend stalls will be available for occupation at 1:00 pm Friday June 11th. Stall assignments will be posted. There is to be no stall moving or swapping permitted unless prior permission is granted by the show office. Shavings are available for pre-purchase for \$10.00/bale. Shavings are the only permitted bedding to be used.

Dogs are **not** allowed on site.

Memberships:

Memberships purchased in 2020 remain valid and 2020 members may take advantage of the member discount without the need to purchase an additional 2021 membership. If you did not purchase a club membership in 2020, then you will need to purchase a 2021 membership in order to receive the discount.

SHF year-end awards: Nominated riders are eligible to earn points from placings in Heritage/Prairie Cup classes and these points will count towards year end awards. Please ensure that you have nominated if you are interested in accumulating points for these awards. Riders must nominate prior to receiving scores in order for these scores to count (there is no retroactive points tabulation).

<u>Placings:</u> Class placings are to be split for junior and senior riders Saturday and Sunday. Championships to be determined as open. Only juniors will receive ribbons.

<u>Championships:</u> Prizes to be awarded for level Champions and Reserve Champions as well as Junior High Point Champion. Levels may be combined where there are fewer than 5 entries per level. Championships will be calculated using the total of the highest score at the level per day.

<u>Thoroughbred Incentive Program:</u> An award will be presented to the show High Point Thoroughbred registered in the TIP.
