Safety Procedures for Swift Current New Frontier Lighthouse Show 2021

General Safety Committee Activity

Prior to horse arrival:

Check stall conditions:

- Have protruding nails, etc., removed.
- Stall doors should all be in working order.
- Stalls shall be marked so paid competitors can easily find their designated area.
- Any areas needing repair shall be reported to committee/maintenance personnel.

Check barn and arena areas:

- Ensure adequate garbage disposal.
- Check water outlets.
- Check ring conditions-remove debris or rocks, work ground and water if needed.
- Designated no parking or driving areas in place
- Check barn lighting.
- Locate fire equipment

During **Show**:

- Vehicles must be parked so as not to obstruct doors or impede horse/people traffic.
- Trailers are to be parked in designated and assigned spots, so as not impede horse/people traffic.
- No stabling for stallions. They must be kept on trailer when not showing.
- Smoking is not permitted in barns.
- All dogs must be kept on a leash
- Security personnel is available on grounds during the duration of the event.
- Ring entrances must be kept clear so horses can enter and exit arenas safely.
- No practicing with class equipment prior to classes
- All concerns/problems must be reported to show committee and appointed barn boss
- All stalls will be checked upon checkout to ensure cleanliness.
- List of emergency numbers and people will be posted

Participants:

- All junior exhibitors must have protective headgear and appropriate footwear at all times when dealing with horses
- A warm up arena will be available
- Patterns to be posted a minimum of 1 hour before class

Specific Situations:

- The safety committee and show committee will agree prior to an event, whom will phone 911 or contact the main exhibition office as required. Backup person will also be identified.
- In severe weather conditions, all people are to move to one of the two designated buildings (the Stockade and the Pavilion) to wait out the weather and receive directions from the Swift Current Agriculture and Exhibition staff.
- Outside gates are staffed by Exhibition volunteers at all times when open. One gate is open 24 hours and the others are locked after a certain time and reopen in the morning.

Fire:

- What must be done depends on the severity of the fire, and where it is located.
- As this is an outdoor show, all people and animals will be moved away from the fire.
- Animals and people will be removed from barn and doors shut to prevent animals or people from going back inside.
- One safety committee member will be assigned to call fire department and main office. The fire department will be asked to cut their sirens as they approach so as not to panic the horses.

Accident:

- 911 can be called.
- Main exhibition office will be notified.
- Unconscious people will not be moved.
- Available veterinarian on call
- Cards on the outside of stalls for participants to list emergency contact numbers.
- Accident reports are completed in the event of a serious accident and submitted to the SHF.

COVID-19 Rules

Physical distancing guidelines and sanitation procedures as per Sask Health will be in effect to ensure the safest possible environment for everyone involved.

It is expected that all 4-H events and activities, including sanctioned events, follow Public Health Orders and the applicable guidelines in the Re Open Saskatchewan Plan.

NEW FRONTIER RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read thoroughly.

1. This show will follow SHF rules.
2. Saskatchewan Horse Federation Membership - "Promoting Equine Excellence". Please check their website, www.saskhorse.ca to find out about all the benefits of membership. Nominated riders are eligible to earn points from placings in Heritage classes and these points will count towards year end awards. Please ensure your SHF membership is current and that you have nominated if you are interested in accumulating points for the awards.
3. This show is also a member of the Cypress Horse Shows. Member shows include Swift Current, Eastend, Shaunavon, Maple Creek and Medicine Hat. Membership is automatic and complimentary to the mini circuit to qualify for year-end awards. Points tabulated after your first entry in a member show.
4. Entries due by July 1st, 2021. Late entries will be accepted until 1 hour before class commences. No refunds without medical/vet letters.
5. Points for Hi Point will be given to 1 combination of horse & rider.
6. Behavior:
 - a. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, or driver may disqualify the entry. Proper etiquette is expected of exhibitors and family members both in and out of the arena.
 - b. Disputes/disagreements are to follow the Agricultural and Exhibition Association Code of Conduct, which is that all are to be submitted in writing to the Swift Current Ag & Ex General Manager, along with a \$5.00 fee. Decision will be established within 24 hours.
7. Multiple entries by horses and riders are allowed as long as the horse does not compete against themselves. Multiple entries may be restricted based on time restrictions.
8. Stallions must be ridden and handled by adults. Stallions must be attended to properly.
9. Stalls/pens are only reserved if paid in full with your entry form. Barn space will be available commencing July 8th. Limited 8' x 8' box stalling (40) and 34 outside pens. Horse owners are responsible for their horses' bedding and feed. **No stalling available for stallions.** Stalls must be cleaned, or an additional fee will be charged. Tack stalls subject to stall availability. Please contact the exhibition office at 306-773-2944.
10. A Stall Clean Out cheque must be submitted with all entries. See entry form for amount. Clean out applies for box stalls and outside pens.
11. All youth under the age of 18 as of Jan 1st of the current year will be required to wear approved astm/sei helmet while participating in any event sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation including showmanship and halter classes.
12. There will be no cross entering between Pee Wee/Junior Riding class riders or leadline classes.
13. All exhibitors must follow posted ring regulations.
14. Family members may share horses, but the horse cannot compete against itself.
15. The Committee may cancel or combine any class that has 3 or fewer entries.
16. Horses shall not be punished unnecessarily or severely.
17. No liquor allowed in barns. No smoking in barns.
18. The Committee reserves the right to call a veterinarian to inspect horses suspected of being ill and to remove these horses to a sick bay.
19. No practicing on class equipment.
20. Liability waiver must be signed and turned in before being allowed to show.
21. Riders may only enter in one age division (Contestants may enter up an age division, not down as per SHF regulations).
