## General Rules

1. The show will be held under the rules and regulations of the S.H.F. Heritage Handbook. The show committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any errors in the prize list.
2. Should any questions or disputes arise not covered in the rules it shall be referred to the show committee whose decision will be final.
3. No person other than officials may enter the ring without the permission of the show committee
4. Class may be combined or cancelled if there are less than 3 entries. Entry fees will be refunded if a class is cancelled. All changes will be announced or printed.
5. In the case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that was awarded to the disqualified animal and the other prizes adjusted accordingly.
6. Age of rider will be as of January 1, 2021; as follows Riders may enter ONLY in their age group other than Pee Wee

**\*\*please enter one or the other: PeeWee OR Junior C\*\***

**PEEWEE: 8 years and under JR. C: 11 years and under  
JR. B: 12-14 years JR. A: 15-17 years ADULT: 18 Years and Over**

Effective April 1, 2010 all youth under the age of 18 years as of January 1 of the current year are required wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet when participating in any competition sanctioned by the S.H.F. for insurance purposes.

7. Age of the horse is as of January 1, 2021. Jr. horses are 5 years and under and may be shown in a snaffle bridle/bosal and two hands may be used.
8. A horse may not be used by more than one rider in the same event. A horse may be shown in Jr. A barrels and PeeWee Poles but not in Jr. A barrels and Jr. B barrels. With the exception of peewee classes, which a horse may be used by a peewee and any other age rider at the show! This includes open classes.
9. A rider may show **no more than 2 horses in an individually judged class**, for example: trail, reining, gymkhana events, etc. Only one Horse/Handler combination will be allowed per regular halter classes.
10. Exhibitors are to be at the hitching ring when their class is called. The gate will be held for tack changes when notified, for no more than 3 minutes.
11. Correct number is to be worn for each horse. **The number must be clearly visible and no bridle numbers will be allowed.** Please return the numbers to the show office when done.
12. The classes will run in the order listed in the prize list.
13. Handlers of stallions must be adult competitors.
14. If you must bring a dog we ask that it be kept on a leash and away from the ring.

**We are asking all participants to have a SHF, AEF or other provincial membership this year for insurance purposes. If you do not have one, you will show at your own risk.**

We are members of the **Saskatchewan Heritage Circuit** and **Cypress Horse Shows**. A Saskatchewan Horse Federation membership is **not** required to show, but to earn circuit points you must be nominated to the **SHF Heritage Circuit** ([www.saskhorse.ca/hc-competitors](http://www.saskhorse.ca/hc-competitors)). To earn points to the **Cypress Horse Shows** please check their Facebook page-Cypress Horse Shows. The Maple Creek Light Horse Show **will not require a negative coggins test** and will be a SK "C" designation event, unless mandated by the CFIA (Canadian Food Inspection Agency). We encourage all horse owners to familiarize themselves with biosecurity practices when attending any horse event.

Exhibitors canceling entries must notify the secretary before the class. Entry fee will be refunded with a certificate from a veterinarian. A substitute may be accepted, but only for the classes originally entered. Any additional classes would be a post entry.
