2022 was a busy year for the SHF. The Heritage Classic and the Prairie Cup competition circuits started up with more shows than in the two previous years, which was a nice rebound from the pandemic numbers. In September, we hosted our Provincial Championship Show for the Heritage Classic Circuit, and we thank the competitors and volunteers that showed up in Moose Jaw to support the event.

In February the SHF welcomed our new Executive Director, Greg Laroque to the fold. Greg is a great addition to our staff, and we look forward to working with him on a variety of upcoming programs.

During a Board retreat and meeting session held on October 13 & 14, 2022, a facilitator presented SHF directors with a detailed account of required governance updates that are needed to bring our organization into the next 'generation'. After the session, the Governance Committee followed up on Board direction to update and better align our constitution with the Non-Profit Act, and to review our Articles of Incorporation. These will be presented to the members at the AGM. I would like to thank Lisa Graham for all the hard work that she put into the SHF since July 2020 until November 29, 2022 at which time she tendered her resignation from her position as President and Board member, citing personal reasons. We wish her all the best in future endeavors.

As interim President, my role began mid-December, so other than finishing up on Grants and year-end assignments, I have had the pleasure to be focused on what we have to look forward to. We are in an enviable position financially, so the upcoming year is full of possibilities for expanding on existing programs as well as initiating some new ones. 2023 promises to be a busy year. A High-Performance Symposium July with great guest clinicians for our HP riders in Dressage, Jumping and Reining. New ideas for a bigger and better Heritage and Prairie Cup competitions are on the horizon. Provincials in the fall. Improvements to our Hall of Fame. Watch for dates for Officials and Coaching upgrades. And of course...Grants. We have funding from Sask Sport that allows us to support you, our members, so let's get out there and take advantage of these opportunities.
