A Horse/Rider combination must be Heritage Circuit Nominated on or before September 15th, 2025. To be eligible to enter the Provincial Finals, the nominated horse/rider combo must attend at least two Heritage Circuit shows. To be eligible to enter any class in one of the nine divisions, the nominated horse/rider combo must have placed in the top five in at least one class within that division.

## Entries

- Submit your entry by September 3<sup>rd</sup> to receive a FREE Heritage Provincials Hoodie. Please specify size on entry form: S, M, L, XL or XXL (if no size is specified, XL will be provided). One per person, **NOT per entry**. After September 3<sup>rd</sup>, SHF Provincials zip up hoodies will be available for purchase at the show for \$40.00 - sizes and quantities cannot be guaranteed when purchased at the show.
- Entries close **September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025**. A \$25 late fee will apply for entries received or postmarked after September 15<sup>th</sup>. New entries will not be accepted at the show. Payment is due with an entry form. Entry forms submitted without payment **will not be** considered complete. If exhibitors want to add additional classes at the show, **24 hours** notice must be given to the show office with full payment to be eligible to enter any extra classes.
- Shavings are available only if pre-ordered on your entry form. There will not be extra shavings available at the show.

## Fees

**Regular classes** are \$12 each.

**Stake classes** are \$25 each.

**Dressage and Western Dressage:** English Introductory Level & WSDAC Intro Level tests are \$20 each. All the others are \$25 each

**Hunter:** Height division Entry Fee is \$45 and includes entry to all classes within that height division (Over Fences, Under Saddle, and Stake).

## Prizes

Ribbons will be awarded in all classes from 1st to 6th.

All classes will receive prize money from 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> place.

**Regular Class Payout:** 1st - \$25; 2nd - \$20; 3rd - \$15; 4th - \$10

**Stake Classes Payout:** 1st - \$60 + 40% add back; 2nd - \$45 + 30% add back; 3rd - \$30 + 20% add back; 4th \$15 + 10% addback.

Prize money from Stake Classes will be paid out after the show by cheque.

**Class & Division Champions and Reserve Champions** will be awarded (except Junior Horse).

**Division Champion and Reserve Champion only for Equitation**

**Highest Average Score will determine Dressage & Western Dressage Champions & Reserve Champions**

Ties for Championships will be broken by the following:

- Entries must have placed in the Stake class to be eligible for a Class Championship.
- Entries must have placed in at least one Stake class to be eligible for a Division Championship.
- Number of entries beat will determine any ties for Equitation Championship.

## Show Office Hours

Thursday 1PM –4PM; Friday/Saturday 7AM – ½ an hour after last class; Sunday 7AM – ½ an hour after competition conclusion.

## Warm Up Rounds

The Golden Mile Arena will be available for competitors to ride in on Thursday from 2:00 PM until 9:00 PM.

Warm Up Rounds for Dressage will start on Thursday at 2:00 PM. Cost is \$15 for 15 minutes.

The Hunter course will be open for warm up rounds beginning after the completion of Dressage classes on Friday, until 7:00 PM. It will also be available on Saturday from 11:00 AM to ½ hour prior to start of Hunters. The cost is \$15 per horse.

# General Rules & Regulations

Please read carefully the following general rules.

1. The Heritage Provincial Finals will follow all the rules and regulations described in the Heritage handbook found on the website at: <http://saskhorse.ca/rulebooks>. Under which, we will also be following the individual discipline rules set by the National governing organizations such as Equestrian Canada, and Western Style Dressage Association of Canada.
2. SHF Helmet Policy: All youth under the age of 18 as of January 1st of the current year will be required to wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet.
3. All Junior and Senior riders in English Dressage, regardless of the level they are competing at, must wear an approved helmet. All Junior Western Dressage riders, regardless of the level they are competing at, must wear an approved helmet. Senior Western Dressage riders may wear a western hat or an approved helmet.

4. **The Show Committee reserves the right to combine Age Groups when there are fewer than 4 entries in any class. Any English or Western Dressage classes or any Hunter Division with fewer than 4 entries will be cancelled.**
5. Dressage riders are to provide their own reader, if required. Readers will NOT be provided by the SHF.
6. All horses must wear their number when outside of their stall. While competing, numbers must either be worn on the rider's back or clearly displayed on both sides of the saddle pad. Exception: Bridle numbers may be used in Hunter Over Fences and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, but a back number must be worn in Hunter Under Saddle classes.
7. Obvious sideline coaching or obvious ringside assistance while rider is being judged may result in the disqualification of the exhibitor.
8. Discipline: Competitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider or member of the family participating in the show will disqualify the horse and exhibitor. The management of the show has the right to remove a groom, horse, rider or driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.
9. In Hunters, a horse/rider combination may compete at a maximum of three consecutive heights at the competition. A horse may compete in a maximum of four over-fence classes per day, including equitation over fences.
10. In Dressage and Western Dressage, a horse/rider combination may compete in any two, but only two consecutive levels at the competition. A horse may compete in a maximum of four tests per day (combined English and Western Dressage).
11. Each horse requires a stall, including single day entries. Please note: Due to insurance requirements, Moose Jaw Exhibition Company regulations do not permit horses tied to the trailer. Participants who are not in compliance will be excluded from competition and entries will be forfeited.
12. Coggins testing is recommended but is not required.
13. In a Hunter Division, a horse must be shown in the regular Hunter class Over Fences to be eligible to compete in the Under Saddle &/or the Stake Class. A horse must be shown in the regular class of a division to be eligible to compete in the stake class.
14. Medications Control: The Saskatchewan Horse Federation reserves the right to do random drug testing at this show. Anyone failing to comply may face disqualification.
15. Animal Welfare: The Saskatchewan Horse Federation is dedicated to the humane treatment and welfare of horses. Cruel, abusive or inhumane treatment of a horse at any SHF Circuit competition by an exhibitor, owner, trainer or other person will not be tolerated anywhere on the grounds under any circumstances. The SHF supports any decision of officials or show committees that removes a horse from a competition due to obvious lameness or exhaustion.

Cruelty can be defined as intentionally causing pain or unnecessary discomfort to a horse. The standard by which such conduct or treatment will be measured is that a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would be determined to be cruel, excessive or inhumane.
16. Lameness: **Obvious** lameness in any Class or event may be cause for disqualification. If a horse exhibits one or more signs of lameness, the judge may choose from the following:

- To not consider a lame horse for placing

- To give a lame horse a zero or 'no' score
  - To ask that the horse be excused from a class
17. **Scratches:** Any entry that scratches a class during the show is not eligible for a refund. Cancellation of entries after the entry closing date will have all fees refunded except the \$30.00 Admin/Office fee. A certified medical doctor or veterinary certificate must be provided.
18. If a Class or Division is cancelled by the Committee, applicable fees will be refunded.
19. **Protests:** Any protest must be made in writing and signed by the complainant. It must be submitted, along with a \$25 cheque, within one hour of the completion of the class in question. A protest must contain a specific statement of an alleged violation of a rule or a condition of a class. It must provide the full name (and address, if possible) of the alleged violator. The show committee (and the judge, if they choose) will review the protest and determine a ruling based on the rules and regulations under which the show is sanctioned. Their decision shall be final. Protest fees will be returned only if the ruling is made in favor of the complainant. This procedure will take precedence over all other protest procedures.
20. **Schedule:** Riders exhibiting more than one horse in classes where entries show one at a time will be scheduled to allow for a tack change, however, horses must be ready to go when called. Rail classes will take priority over scheduled classes when necessary.

Because of the multi-discipline nature of this show, the show committee reserves the right to move scheduled classes at the judge's discretion. Dressage riders may be required to ride before their posted times if possible. We will do our best to accommodate all riders as needed, so please be aware of how classes are moving and be prepared if necessary. If you foresee a conflict, please let the gate know as soon as possible.
