Reining

June 13th, 14th, and 15th, 2025 at Prairieland Park (Saskatoon) with Clinician Hubert Heule

Hunter/Jumper

June 20th, 21st and 22nd, 2025 at East Edge Equestrian (Saskatoon) with Clinician Alex Grayton

Dressage

June 21st and 22nd, 2025, at East Edge Equestrian (Saskatoon) with Clinician Belinda Trussell

Deadline for Application (All Disciplines): April 30, 2025

High-Performance riders will be assessed according to the following information.

- 1. Strong competition results are primary indicators of high-performance status** although all factors (below) will be used for overall assessment. Providing official proof of recent competition results will aid the committee in selection. A rider's competition results must meet minimum HP requirements. See Technical Package.
- 2.** Riders competing on the cusp of high-performance are eligible to apply for a Talent ID spot if the HP positions are not filled. Athletes with strong competition results may be considered for Talent ID.
- 3.** An athlete who has previously achieved HP status but not actively competing is still eligible to apply. Information regarding years absent from competition should accompany this application.
- 4.** Previously identified HP athletes who are currently riding a young horse are eligible to apply. Your horse must have the potential to reach HP status.
- 5.** Please list major accomplishments spanning back at least 5 years.
- 6.** Please provide any information regarding your involvement with the Saskatchewan horse community. This includes your membership with SHF, Prairie Cup nomination, Provincial Discipline Group membership/involvement. This could also include coaching, competition organizing, volunteering, etc.

Applications will be assessed by the SHF High-Performance Committee and athletes ranked according to the information supplied in their application form. The process may also include consultation with provincial discipline representatives, HP coaches and officials.

Once the applicants are ranked, the top riders (pending clinician limits) will be notified of their eligibility and given a date by which they must confirm their attendance and remit clinic fees. **Eligible participants who have not paid by the deadline will forfeit their spot to the next rider on the list.**

If there are insufficient riders to fill HP spots, Talent ID riders will fill the remaining openings and will be invited in order of their ranking.

Certificates for vaccination or negative EIA status will be determined by the host facility. SHF Equine Health and Welfare guidelines require horses to be fit enough to participate in HP sessions spanning the days of the clinic. Withdrawal of either horse or rider will require a vet/doctor's letter to qualify for reimbursement. A \$50.00 administration fee will be applied to all cancellations.
