Saskatchewan Horse Federation (SHF) 2022 Lucky Horseshoe Raffle Rules of Play

Rules governing the conduct of the Lucky Horseshoe Raffle, including the Draw and awarding of Prizes:

- i. Saskatchewan Horse Federation employees, and members of their immediate family are not eligible to win prizes in raffles for which they provide services.
- ii. Raffle Tickets sales must take place within Saskatchewan only.
- iii. The purchase price of the ticket is 1 for \$5.00.
- iv. A total of number of 8000 tickets will be available for sale.
- v. The draw will be held at the Saskatchewan Horse Federation office, 300 - 1734 Elphinstone St, Regina SK on October 26, 2022 at 3:00 pm. The draw is open to the public.
- vi. The draw location is # 300 – 1734 Elphinstone Street, Regina, SK.
- vii. Tickets will be drawn by a method of random selection and witnessed by a minimum of two observers of a non-participating party and a member the Saskatchewan Horse Federation. None of these individuals shall be the person conducting the draw.
 - a. The draw order will be highest prize value drawn first proceeding to lowest prize value.
 - b. Winners will be contacted by telephone by the SHF office and advised how to claim prizes. Once all winners have been contacted, the winners will be announced on the SHF website at www.saskhorse.ca and the SHF Facebook page.

- ix.
 - a. Winners are not required to be present at the time of draw to claim prizes.

- e. Winners for each prize will be recorded and verified by a member of the observing group (item vi. above). All winning tickets drawn shall be returned to the draw drum after each draw to allow for equal opportunity to participate in all draws.
- f. All unclaimed prizes will be held in a secure location for a period of one year from the October 26, 2022 draw date. If prizes go unclaimed beyond the hold date, they will be distributed to a charitable organization approved by SLGA in accordance with Section 13(d) of SLGA Terms and Conditions.
- g. All prizes listed in viii above will be drawn for.
