- Applicants for Recorded Judge status must be a minimum of 18 years of age to apply and be a current individual member of the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.
- Applicants for Primary or Senior Judge status must be a minimum of 21 years of age to apply and be a current individual member of the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.

#### SHF Recorded Hunter/Jumper Officials

**The Recorded Hunter/Jumper Official** is in training to become an official and is not eligible to judge independently. To apply to become a Primary judge, a Recorded Official must complete the following steps.

Step 1 Complete an SHF Hunter/Jumper judge's application form.

**Step 2** Order or download a Current Heritage/Prairie Cup Handbook. It is recommended that you also have a current EC Hunter/Jumper Rule book.

**Step 3** Attend a SHF provincial or EC Hunter/Jumper judge's clinic.

**Step 4** Applicants for Recorded status are required to pass the Hunter/Jumper Judge written exam with a minimum of 80%. This exam will be provided/administered after attending a Hunter/Jumper Judges clinic

**Step 5** Applicants <u>must</u> meet minimum shadow judging requirements. Recorded Status applicants are required to shadow judge with a SHF Senior Hunter/Jumper Judge or an EC Recorded Hunter/Jumper Judge (or above) for a minimum of seven (7) show days. Show days must be under at least three different officials and may be accumulated at multi-day shows. For shadow judge procedure information or to obtain a Shadow Judging Form, contact the SHF office.

**Step 6** Applicants are requested to provide proof of EC Hunter/Jumper competition experience at a minimum height of 3'.

Once the requirements of 1-6 are completed, application can be made to the SHF Officials Committee for advancement to Primary Hunter/Jumper Judge Status, allowing eligibility to judge independently

### SHF Primary Hunter/Jumper Officials

**The Primary Hunter/Jumper Official** is qualified to judge Provincial level Hunter/Jumper Shows including Heritage Level Hunters. They may also judge any height of Hunter and Jumper classes at sanctioned PC competitions <u>provided courses are designed by an accredited EC or USEF course designer who is also officiating at that competition.</u>

To maintain current judge's status, judges are required to:

- Maintain an individual membership with the SHF;
- Attend a SHF or EC Hunter/Jumper judge's clinic at least once every three years;
- Write the rule book exam once every three years, passing with a score of 80%;
- Judge seven (7) Heritage, PC or EC sanctioned (\*must EC Carded to judge at EC shows) competitions within a three-year period before applying for Senior status;
- Complete the Respect in Sport module found here <a href="https://sasksrc.respectgroupinc.com/">https://sasksrc.respectgroupinc.com/</a>
- Keep records of all activities related to maintaining and/or advancing their officials status, and to share these with the SHF office.

Once the above requirements are met, application can be made to the SHF Officials Committee for advancement to Provincial Senior Hunter/Jumper Judge Status.

## **SHF Senior Hunter/Jumper Officials**

**The Senior H/J Official** is qualified to judge Provincial level Hunter/Jumper Shows including Heritage Level Hunters. They may also judge any height of Hunter and Jumper classes at sanctioned PC competitions provided courses are designed by an accredited EC or USEF course designer who is also officiating at that competition. Senior judges are also eligible to mentor (shadow) recorded and primary status officials.

To maintain current judge's status, judges are required to:

- Maintain an individual membership with the SHF;
- Attend a SHF or EC Hunter/Jumper judge's clinic at least once every three years;
- Write the rule book exam once every three years, passing with a score of 80%;
- Complete the Respect in Sport module found here <a href="https://sasksrc.respectgroupinc.com/">https://sasksrc.respectgroupinc.com/</a>
- Keep records of all activities related to maintaining and/or advancing their officials status, and to share these with the SHF office.
