



## SASKATCHEWAN — SPORTS — HALL OF FAME

SHF members receive **free entry** to the Saskatchewan Sports Hall of Fame, with proof of SHF membership!

In 1966, the Amateur Athletic Union of Canada-Saskatchewan Branch and Molson Brewery partnered to form the Molson Sports Hall of Fame. It was located in the Molson's Hospitality House (on Dewdney Avenue).

In 1974 the Hall of Fame joined with SaskSport and was renamed the Saskatchewan Sports Hall of Fame (SSHF) and moved to Saskatchewan Drive.

In 1979 the SSHF relocated to its current location in the former Land Titles building, located at 2205 Victoria Avenue.

There are 527 inductees in the Hall of Fame (including the 2019 inductees)

- 239 athletes
- 163 builders
- 125 championship teams
- 52 sports are represented in the Hall of Fame.
